Interview Questions – Finances

You should be prepared to answer questions that may feel very personal and may even be considered to be rude in your culture. For example, they may want to know exactly how you will pay for your course and support yourself while you are studying in the UK.

They may also ask you to explain, in detail, where the funds in your possession have come from. If you are being supported by family members then you should be able to explain how they obtained their funds, so you may want to have a conversation with your parents about that.
